The Conversion of the Jailor

TEXT: Acts 16:16-34

INTRODUCTION:

- A. USED TO TEACH FAITH ONLY SALVATION.
 - 1. What was the answer to the jailor's question?
 - 2. Only faith is mentioned, faith alone must be okay.
- B. WHAT CAN WE LEARN ABOUT CONVERSION FROM THIS?

I. THIS TYPE OF REASONING PITS ONE PASSAGE AGAINST ANOTHER.

- A. Acts 16:31. ONLY FAITH MENTIONED.
- B. Acts 22:16. ONLY BAPTISM MENTIONED.
- C. Acts 2:38. REPENTANCE AND BAPTISM.
- D. THUS WE HAVE 3 DISTINCT THEORIES.
- E. THIS PASSAGE IS OFTEN LINKED WITH **Eph. 2:8-9** TO SHOW MAN HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH HIS OWN SALVATION; THAT THERE IS NO CONNECTION BETWEEN SALVATION AND WORKS. BUT IN THIS PASSAGE, **FAITH IS A WORK** (John 6:39).

II. THE JAILOR'S QUESTION - AND PAUL'S ANSWER.

- A. "WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?"
- B. IN ANSWERING, PAUL GAVE AN ANSWER CONSISTENT WITH THE SPIRITUAL CONDITION OF THE JAILOR.
 - 1. He'd never heard about Jesus, or what to believe about him.
 - 2. So Paul **started where he was**.
 - 3. Illustrations:
 - a. How do you bake a pie? In an oven, from a recipe, carefully?
 - b. Different people give differing directions when asked.
- C. CONSIDER WHAT PAUL SAID MORE CLOSELY.
 - 1. He didn't say faith only, before he could do anything else.
 - 2. He also **spoke unto him the word** of the Lord. **Why**?

III. WHAT DID THE JAILOR DO WHEN HE HEARD THE WORD OF THE LORD?

A. HE OBVIOUSLY **BELIEVED**.

- B. HE **REPENTED** SHOWN BY KINDNESS AND HOSPITALITY.
- C. HE WAS BAPTIZED IMMEDIATELY. WHY?
 - 1. They had spoken the word of the Lord to him.
 - 2. What is the word of the Lord(Mat. 28:19-20; Mark 16:16).

IV. WHO WAS BAPTIZED? WERE ANY BABIES BAPTIZED?

- A. WHO SAID THERE WERE BABIES IN HIS HOUSE?
- B. BABIES DON'T NEED IT(Ez. 18).
- C. IF BABIES DID, IT WOULD DO THEM NO GOOD.
 - 1. Can't repent(Acts 17:30).
 - 2. Can't confess(Matt. 10:32-33).
 - 3. Can't believe(Mark 16:15-16).
- D. THOSE WHO WERE BAPTIZED INCLUDED ALL WHO COULD RESPOND (Acts 2:38; Mark 16:16).

CONCLUSION: WHAT ABOUT YOU?
