# **TEXT: 1 Kings 22:1-14**

# **INTRODUCTION:**

- A. MICAIAH'S STATEMENT TOOK COURAGE.
- B. THE POSITION OF GOSPEL TEACHERS TODAY IS THE SAME.
- C. A PARALLEL "WHAT THE LORD SAITH...THAT WILL I SPEAK."

## I. ONE OF OUR GREATEST OBSTACLES IS PREJUDICE.

- A. AHAB HAD HIS MIND MADE UP BEFOREHAND( vs. 3-4 ).
- B. NOTE HIS REACTION TO JEHOSHAPHAT'S PRECAUTION(vs. 5-8).
  - 1. This is the attitude Paul feared the most (Gal. 4:16).
  - 2. Jesus warned against it( **Mat. 13:14-15** ).
  - 3. We should place a proper value on truth( Prov. 23:23 ).
- C. SEE HIS REACTION WHEN TOLD HE WOULD PERISH(vs. 26-28).
- D. AHAB DISREGARDED GOD'S WARNING. HE ACCEPTED ONLY WHAT
  HE WANTED\_TO HEAR. SO GOD SENT HIM A MULTITUDE OF LIARS THAT
  HE MIGHT BE I
  DESTROYED.
  - 1. Judah was like Ahab in the days of Ezekiel (Ez. 14:1-5).
  - 2. Could we be "no better" than Ahab? (2 Thes. 2:10-12).
  - 3. What do you want to hear?( 2 Tim. 4:3-4).
- E. MICAIAH WAS RIGHT IN STANDING FOR THE TRUTH. THE SCORN AND PUNISHMENT OF AHAB DIDN'T CHANGE THE TRUTH.

#### II. MAJORITY DOES NOT CHANGE WHAT IS RIGHT.

- A. 400 FALSE PROPHETS AGAINST MICAIAH GOD'S PROPHET.
- B. 400 FALSE PROPHETS WEREN'T ENOUGH FOR JEHOSHAPHAT(vs. 7).
  - 1. He desired to consult God in spite of the opinions of 400.
  - 2. We need to learn the majority is not always right( Mat. 7:13-14 ).

# III. WE CAN LEARN FROM MICAIAH'S COURAGE.

- A. THE MESSENGER'S WORDS HAD OBVIOUS IMPLICATIONS( vs. 13 ).
- B. MICAIAH'S REPLY(vs. 14).
- C. MANY TIMES WE ARE UNDER THE SAME PRESSURE TODAY.
- 1. Gal. 1:8-10. 1 Pet. 4:11. 1 Cor. 2:12-13. Acts 5:29.
- 2. Jude 3. 2 Tim. 4:2-4. 1:13-14. Amos 3:8.
