II. THE BEGINNING OF MAN.

- A. MAN WAS CREATED TO RULE & HAVE DOMINION(Gen. 1:26-28).
 - 1. He was given work to do(**2:15**).
 - 2. His primary duty(Ecc. 12:13-14).
- B. MAN IS A TRIUNE BEING(1 Thes. 5:23).
 - 1. We are God's offspring(Acts 17:28-29; John 4:24).
 - 2. Man is a moral being CHOICE(Rev. 22:17; Josh. 24:15).

III. THE BEGINNING OF SIN.

- A. THERE WAS ONE RESTRICTION PLACED ON MAN(Gen. 2:16-17).
- 1. **Positive** law, not a **moral** law.

B.

- 2. Not for the purpose of tempting(James 1:13-15).
- THE TEMPTATION CAME FROM SATAN(ch. 3).
- Notice the 3-fold appeal(Gen. 3:6).
 We are tempted in the same way(1 John 2:15-17).
- C. SIN IS ACTING CONTRARY TO GOD'S WILL.
- Sins of "commission" (1 John 3:4).
 Sins of "ommission" (James 4:17).
- D. WE ARE ALL IN THE SAME BOAT(Rom. 3:23).

IV. THE BEGINNING OF SINS CONSEQUENCES.

- A. SHAME: fig leaf aprons that couldn't cover(Jer. 10:23).
- B. FEAR: They hid themselves(Heb. 10:31; Mat. 10:28).
- C. WARPED THINKING(1 Tim 4:1-2; Phil. 3:18-19).
- D. COWARDICE(Gen. 3:11-13).
- E. PHYSICAL CURSES serpent(vs. 14-15), woman(16), man(17f.)
- F. DRIVEN FROM GOD'S PRESENCE(Isa. 55;1-2; Eph. 2:1, 12).
- G. PHYSICAL DEATH FOR ALL ADAM'S OFFSPRING(1 Cor.15:22; Rom.5:12).
 - 1. We are all Adam's **<u>physical</u>** offspring, we inherit that
 - which is his **physically physical death**.
 - Spiritually from birth we are God's offspring. Therefore we are born <u>spiritually</u> innocent and alive. Man becomes a spiritual decendent of Adam *only when he does that which Adam did* - SIN(Rom. 3:23; 6:23; Rom. 5:12).
