Lesson 4 ñ The Organization of the Church

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TEXT: Eph. 3:20-21
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INTRODUCTION:

- A. THE CHURCH IS A WONDERFUL BLESSING FROM GOD.
 - 1. An instrument of glory for God.
 - 2. Must be perfect to glorify him.
- B. IT IS SUFFICIENT TO DO GOD'S WORK(1 Tim. 3:15; Eph. 4:11-12)...

I. THE CHURCH IS A DIVINE PLAN DIVINELY EXECUTED.

- A. Heb. 8:1-5. THE TRUE TABERNACLE(vs. 5; 1 Cor. 3:9-11).
- B. A PART OF GOD'S ETERNAL PURPOSE(Eph. 3:10-11; Matt. 16:18).
- D. TO DENY ITS SUFFICIENCY IS TO IMPEACH GOD'S WISDOM(Isa. 55:8-9; Rom. 11: 33-36).
- E. ARE WE WISE ENOUGH TO IMPROVE ON GOD'S PLAN?(1 Cor. 3:18-20).
- F. A DIVINE REVELATION MAKES KNOWN ALL GOD'S WILL.
 - 1. The H.S. revealed all truth to the Apostles (John 14:26).
 - 2. Able to make us perfect or complete(2 Tim. 3:16-17; 2 Pet. 1:3).
- G. THE BIBLE SETS FORTH WHAT **GOD** WANTS.
 - 1. Matt. 28:18-20. "Observe all things I command you."
 - 2. 2 Pet. 3:15. Paul's writings given by God(Gal. 1:11-12).

PERFECT REVELATION CAN'T SET FORTH IMPERFECT WAYS NOR AN IMPERFECT AND INSUFFICIENT INSTITUTION.

- H. THE WEAKNESS OF HUMAN WISDOM(Gal. 1:6-9; 1 Cor. 4:6).
- I. THE CHURCH FUNCTIONS UNDER DIVINE AUTHORITY AND SUPERVISION.
 - 1. Jesus is the head of the body(Eph. 1:22-23; Col. 3:17; 2 John 9).
 - 2. The apostles teachings are authoritative (John 13:20; 1 John 4:6).

II. THE ORGANIZATION OF THE CHURCH.

- A. NO SCRIPTURE FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE UNIVERSAL CHURCH.
- B. AS WE SEE THE LOCAL CHURCH IN THE NEW TESTAMENT, IT IS A GROUP OF CHRISTIANS IN A PARTICULAR PLACE WHO HAVE **AGREED** TO WORK TOGETHER AS A UNIT UNDER A COMMON OVERSIGHT. IN THE LOCAL CHURCH, OR CONGREGATION, THERE IS **POOLING OF RESOURCES, ABILITIES, AND ACTION**.
- C. THE **ORGANIZATION** OF THE LOCAL CHURCH:
 - 1. All organization of the Lordís church is on a local basis. Each local church is **independent** and autonomous insofar as related to men and other churches.
 - 2. Each church is to have its own officers (Phil. 1:1; Acts 14:23; 20:28).
 - 3. The qualifications of bishops are found in 1 Tim. 3:1-14 and Titus 1:5-9.
 - 4. **ABUSES** ñwhat is **not** in the Pattern.
 - a. **Pastor system** ñ The preacher becomes an administrator, the CEO. It surprises many to know that preachers are **not** officers in the local church!
 - b. Unscriptural Terms mean Unscriptural Jobs!

i.e.: Youth minister, Mission Coordinator, Event Manager, Womenís Counselor, Music Director, Social Director, Education Wizard, etc.

- D. WHAT IS THE WORK OF THE DEACON??
 - a. DEACON diakonos, One who executes the commands of another, a servant.
 - b. Acts 6:1-6. Were these men deacons?
 - c. What happens to the appointment when the work is no longer needed?
- E. ELDERÍS WORK IS SEEN IN THE WORDS USED TO DESCRIBE HIS OFFICE.

- 1. *presbuteros*, elder, or presbyter.
- 2. *episcopos*, overseer, or bishop.
- 3. *poimen*, shepherd, pastor. Carries the idea of tending sheep.
- 4. ALL THREE WORDS USED INTERCHANGEABLY (Acts 20:17-28; Titus 1:5-7; 1 Pet. 5:1-3).
- 5. The Work of the Elder:
 - a. Acts 20:28-32. 1. Take heed, 2. Bishop(see footnote), 3. Watch, 4. Commend to the word, 5. Laboring to help the weak.
 - b. 1 Pet. 5:1-5. 1. Tend, 2. Exercise the oversight, 3. Willingly, 4. According to the will of God, 5. Nor for filthy lucre, 6. ready mind, 7. Not lording it over, 8. Setting an example.
 - c. **Titus 1:9**. 1. Holding to the faithful word, 2. Exhort in sound doctrine, 3. Convict the gainsayer.
 - d. Heb. 13:17. 1. Watch, 2. Give account, 3. Authority, Words(Ez. 3:16-21).
 - e. 1 Thess. 5:12.

III. THE JURISDICTION OF THE ELDER IS LIMITED.

- A. WHAT DID GOD PROVIDE CONCERNING ELDERS? (Acts 14:23; Titus 1:5).
- B. THE **JURISDICTION** OF ELDERS IS **SPECIFIED** ñ WHERE THEY WERE MADE BISHOPS! (**Acts 20:28; 1 Pet. 5:2**).
 - 1. Where is the precept, example, or inference for jurisdiction over anything but the church?
 - 2. When God specifies jurisdiction for the elders, all else is excluded.
- C. THEREFORE, THEIR JURISDICTION IS LIMITED TO THE LOCAL CHURCH

WHERE THEY WERE APPOINTED!

- E. THERE IS NO AUTHORITY FOR ELDERS TO OVERSEE ANY OTHER ORGANIZATION.
 - 1. God provided the local church as the only unit of organized and supervised action or work. Individual Christians working together do not necessarily constitute the church working (1 Tim. 5:16). However, the church does nothing except through individuals who are members of it.
 - 2. Where is the Scripture for **Human Institutions** like Missionary Societies, Orphan Homes, Colleges or Preacher Schools, Hospitals, Summer Camps, etc?
 - 3. If there is no Scripture, then it is wrong and sinful for the church to involve itself in such.

CONCLUSION:

A. THE LORD HAS SET FORTH A **PATTERN** IN THE NEW TESTAMENT AS TO WHAT HIS CHURCH IS TO BE LIKE.

B. MOSES WAS GIVEN THIS WARNING CONCERNING THE TABERNACLE(Heb. 8:1-5; 2 John 9).

A. ANY EFFORT TO IMPROVE ON THE WAYS OF GOD DEMONSTRATE A LACK OF FAITH IN HIM.

B. HUMAN INSTITUTIONS - ORPHAN HOMES, MISSIONARY SOCIETIES, etc. INDICATE WE HAVE TURNED AWAY FROM GOD'S WAYS, THEREFORE FROM GOD.
