 - 1. The notion that we are **self-sufficient** our strength is ours (2 Cor. 3:4-5).
 - 2. We are better than our brother (Rom. 14:10; Luke 18:9).
 - 3. We are not to compare ourselves to others (2 Cor. 10:12).
- B. GOD'S ANSWER -
 - 1. **HUMILITY** (Rom. 12:3; 2 Cor. 10:17-18).
 - 2. **TRUST** in the Lord (**Eph. 6:10**).
- C. ILLUSTRATED IN BIBLE CHARACTERS.

- A. MOSES AT AGE 40 THOUGHT HE WAS QUALIFIED TO LEAD.
 - 1. Moses asserted himself by murder (Ex. 2:11-12).
 - 2. His estimation of his own power and influence was **inflated** (vs. 13-15).
- B. 40 YEARS AS A SHEPHERD CHANGED HIS ATTITUDE.
 - 1. Moses didn't appoint himself, but was chosen by God (Ex. 3:1-10).
 - 2. Moses' immediate response reflected his newfound humility (vs. 11).

- A. Judges 6:11-12. GIDEON WAS CALLED BY GOD A MIGHTY MAN OF VALOR.
- B. vs. 13-14. HE WAS CALLED TO DELIVER HIS PEOPLE FROM A SORRY STATE.
- C. HOW DID GIDEON SEE HIMSELF? (vs. 15).
- D. GOD'S PROMISE (vs. 16).
- III. SAUL.
- A. SAUL AS DESCRIBED BY INSPIRATION (1 Sam. 9:1-2).
- B. SAUL, WHEN HE WAS CHOSE HAD A SIMILAR ATTITUDE.
 - 1. When Samuel told him he was chosen, his reaction was this (vs. 21).
 - 2. When he was to be present to the people, he hid (10:21-24).
 - 3. His humility led him to spare his detractors (10:27; 11:12-13).
- C. HE BECAME PROUD AND HIS PRIDE BROUGHT HIM DOWN.
 - 1. His rule a tragedy of acting with a high hand. He was disobedient.
 - 2. His humility was a thing of the past (15:17).
 - 3. As a result, the kingdom was wrested from him (15:19, 26).
