- WHY NOAH FOUND GRACE IN THE EYES OF THE LORD. Ι.
- HE WAS A JUST(KJV) MAN(Gen. 6:9). Righteous(ASV). A.
- HE WAS "PERFECT IN HIS GENERATIONS" (Gen. 6:9). Blameless(NASV). B.
 - Not that he was sinless, but that there were no blatant faults 1.
 - He was a man of moral integrity among the people 2
- C. HE "WALKED WITH GOD"(Gen. 6:9).
 - In walking with God, he imitated the example of Enoch(Gen. 5:24). 1.
 - 2. Walking with God in Noah's case likely involved ...
 - Calling upon the name of the Lord(Gen. 4:26). Faith & Trust. a.
 - Offering sacrifices to God(Gen. 4:3-4). Obedience. b.
- D. HE "DID ACCORDING TO ALL THAT THE LORD COMMANDED HIM."
 - 1. Twice this is emphasized in the Scriptures(Gen. 6:22; 7:5).
 - 2. This obedience of Noah came from faith(Heb. 11:7).
- E. HE WAS "A PREACHER OF RIGHTEOUSNESS"(2 Pet. 2:5).

Ш. WHY WE NEED TO FIND FAVOR.

- NOT BECAUSE WE FACE THE THREAT OF A WORLDWIDE FLOOD. A.
 - 1. God's promise not to destroy the world by flood(Gen. 9:8-11).
 - 2 The rainbow is a constant reminder of God's promise(Gen 9:12-17).
- B. BUT BECAUSE WE FACE THE PROMISE OF THE END OF THE WORLD!
 - The world shall be destroyed by fire when Jesus returns! (2 Pet. 3:3-13). 1.
 - 2. In view of this we must be without spot and blameless(2 Pet. 3:14).
 - 3. Is this not simply another way of saying that we need to be like Noah.
 - 4. Otherwise, we will be like those left outside of the ark when the floods came!

HOW WE CAN FIND GRACE IN THE EYES OF THE LORD. <u>III.</u>

- WE MUST BE "JUST" IN HIS SIGHT. A.
 - 1. God expects righteousness behavior(Rom. 2:13; 1 Pet 3:12; Rev 22:11; Acts 10:35; 1 John 2:29; 3:7-10).
 - 2. Romans 3:23. But we all sin!
 - 3. Justified through forgiveness(Rom. 5:8-9; 1 John 2:1-2; 1:6-7).
 - Justified, we have peace with God(Rom. 5:1). 4.
 - WE MUST BE "PERFECT" IN OUR GENERATION.
 - That is, to be complete, mature, to be everything God desires of us 1.
 - 2. God has provided the necessary elements for us to be "perfect"!
 - The blood of Christ, to cleanse us of our sins(1 John 1:7-9). a.
 - The Word of God, to guide us to completion(2 Tim. 3:16-17). b.
- WE MUST "WALK WITH GOD". C.
 - 1. We can 'no longer walk as the Gentiles walk..."(Eph. 4:17-20).
 - It requires we be "followers of God as dear children"(Eph. 5:1 KJV) "Walk in love"(Eph. 5:2). a.
 - b.
 - "As children of light", exposing the sins of darkness(Eph. 5:8-11).
 - "As wise", understanding of what the Lord's will is(Eph. 5:15-17). c.
 - WE MUST "DO ALL THAT THE LORD HAS COMMANDED".
 - Observing not just "some" things, but "all" things(Matt. 28:20). 1.
 - We demonstrate our faith to be "a living faith" (James 2:17, 24, 26). 2.
- WE MUST BE "PREACHERS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS" E.
 - Christians are lights in a dark world(Phil. 2:14-16). 1.
 - We have in us the light of the gospel(2 Cor. 4:3-6). 2
 - Our influence(Matt. 5:14-16). 3
