 - 2. A rare task requiring the rare character of Joshua.

 - 1. A promise God made good (Josh. 21:43; Neh. 9:7-8).
 - 2. A promise has been made to us (John 14:1-3; 2 Cor. 5:1).

 - 1. Strength from God.
 - 2. God commands us to be strong and mature (1 Cor. 16:13).
 - 3. True strength comes from God (Eph. 6:10).
 - a. How strong is God? (Eph. 1:19-20).
 - b. I can do all things (Phil. 4:13).
 - 4. Where do we find this strength? (Eph. 6:14-17).

 - 3. Because of distraction (2 Tim. 2:3-4; Heb. 12:1).
 - 4. Because of false doctrines (Matt. 15:13-14; Rom. 16:17-18; Col. 2:8).
