- 1. Zarubbabel and Jeshua rebuild the temple.
- Haggai and Zechariah prophesy.
- 2. About 60 years later Ezra comes and teaches the law. Finds people in sinful marriages.
- 3. Nehemiah rebuilds the wall and defenses.
- C. SEEMINGLY GOOD RESULTS.
 - 1. Mind to work (Neh. 4:6). Haggai and Zechariah's prophesies.
 - 2. Reaction to the law (Neh. 8). Watergate.
 - 3. The temple stirs them (Ezra 3:12-13).
- D. CORRUPTION SIN.
 - 1. Malachi. The last word -a call to repentance.
 - 2. The end of Nehemiah He lists problems.

I. THE PROBLEMS OF THE REMNANT – NEHEMIAH'S LIST.

- A. FAILURE TO SUPPORT THE PRIESTHOOD (Neh. 12:44; 13:10).
 - 1. Priests had to take 2nd jobs (13:10).
 - 2. Teachers not back up, evidence in THEIR corruption.
 - 3. A tough job ... (2 Tim. 4:1-2; see Ezra 9:1-4).
 - a. Declare all (Acts 20:26-27).
 - b. Convict (Acts 24:25; Gal. 2:11-14; Mark 6:18).
 - "Am I become your enemy?" Gal. 4:16
 - c. Dull of hearing (Heb. 5:11).
 - 4. Shecaniah's reassurance (Ezra 10:1-4).
- B. MINGLING WITH FOREIGNERS (Neh. 13:1-4).
 - 1. Opposing purposes Different gods No understanding.
 - 2. Zarubbabel and Jeshua vs. Samaritans \rightarrow Lasting enmity.
 - 3. Our fellowship Light vs. Dark.
 - a. Worldliness and sin (2 Cor. 6:14-18).
 - b. Teachers of Error (Rom. 16:17-18).
 - c. Factions and unfaithful (Titus 3:10-11; 2 Thess. 3:6, 14).
 - 4. Three instructions in each case:
 - a. Preach the Word (2 Tim. 4:2; Titus 1:9).
 - b. No compromise (Prov. 23:23).
 - c. No fellowship (Eph. 5:11).
- C. EXALTATION OF FALSE TEACHERS (Neh. 13:4-8).
 - 1. Tobiah's bedroom-Sanballet's son-in-law.
 - 2. We are warned
 - a. (Acts 20:29; Col. 2:8; 1 Tim 1:19-20; 2 Tim 2:16-18; 2 Pet. 2:1-2; Rom 16:17-18).
 - b. Where will we end up? (Matt. 15:13-14).
 - 3. What allows this to happen?
 - a. Itching ears (2 Tim. 4:3-4; Isa. 30:9-11).
 - b. Preachers vs. hirelings (2 Pet. 2:15; 1 Tim. 6:3-5).
 - c. Prejudice and earplugs (2 Thess. 2:10-12; Matt. 13:10-11, 14-15).
 - d. Fear of offending (Matt. 15:12). THE WORD IS A SWORD!
- D. PROFANING THE HOLY (Neh. 13:15-22).
 - 1. The Sabbath (Ex. 20:8-11). They worked anyway.
 - 2. They set at naught God's law (Heb. 10:28-29).
 - a. God will be honored (Heb. 12:28), sanctified (10:31).
 - Isaiah's reaction (Isa. 6:5).
 - Reverend (Psa. 111:9-10; 99).
 - b. And that which he ordains:
 - Marriage (Heb. 13:4).
 - Sabbath day (Neh. 13:17-18; Ex. 31:12-15).
 - Lord's Supper (1 Cor. 10:24-25, 29).
 - Worship (1 Cor. 14:15; John 4:24).
 - His holy word (**Heb. 10:28**).
 - Redeemed self (1 Cor. 6:19-20; 1 Pet. 1:15-16).
- E. THE LANGUAGE OF ASHDOD (Neh. 13:23-24).
 - 1. Denominational terms desensitize to error represented.
 - Confuse the inexperienced and unstable.
 - 2. Devotional, chapel service, sacrament, retreat, revival.

3. Misuse of Scriptural terms - disciple, grace, faith.

CHASED THEM OUT!
