PRESUMPTION.

- A. THE SIN OF PRESUMPTION.
 1. **"To take upon oneself without permission or authority"** (Webster).
 2. **Deut. 18:20.** Without God sending (**Deut. 1:43**)
 3. May be outright rebellion or thoughtlessness. Always deadly!
- B. GOD'S REGARD FOR IT (**Deut. 17:12-13; 18:20; Num. 15:30; 2 Pet. 2:9-10**).
